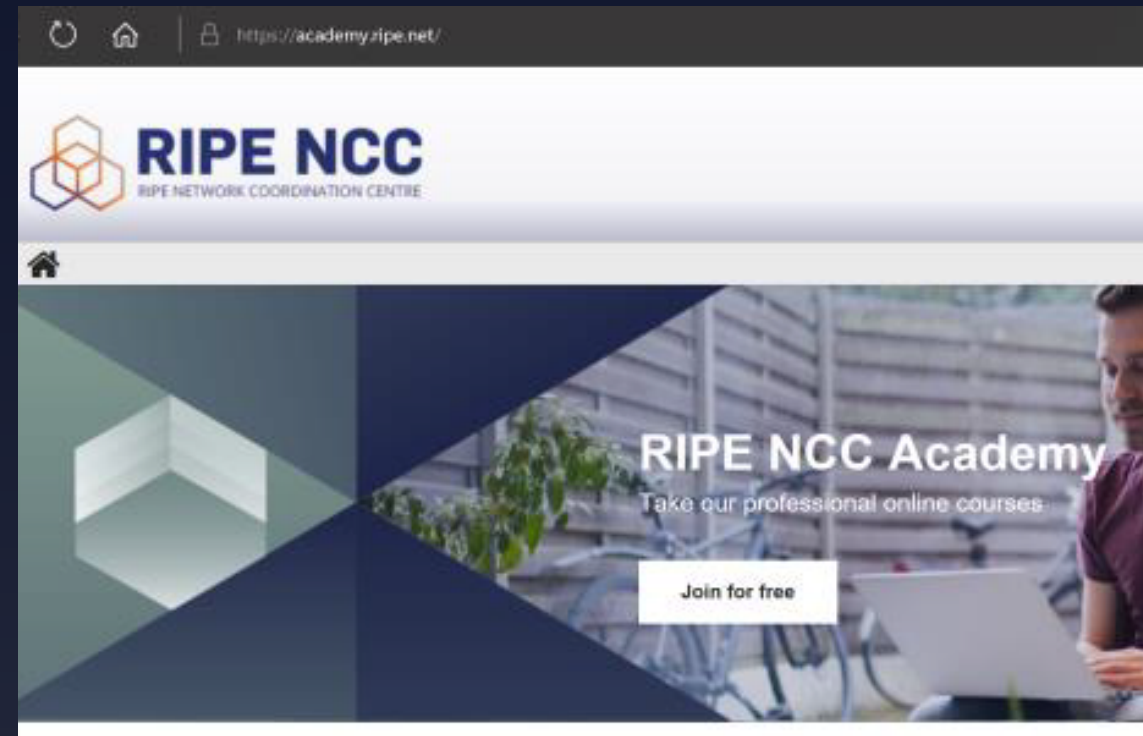
What do the certificates prove?

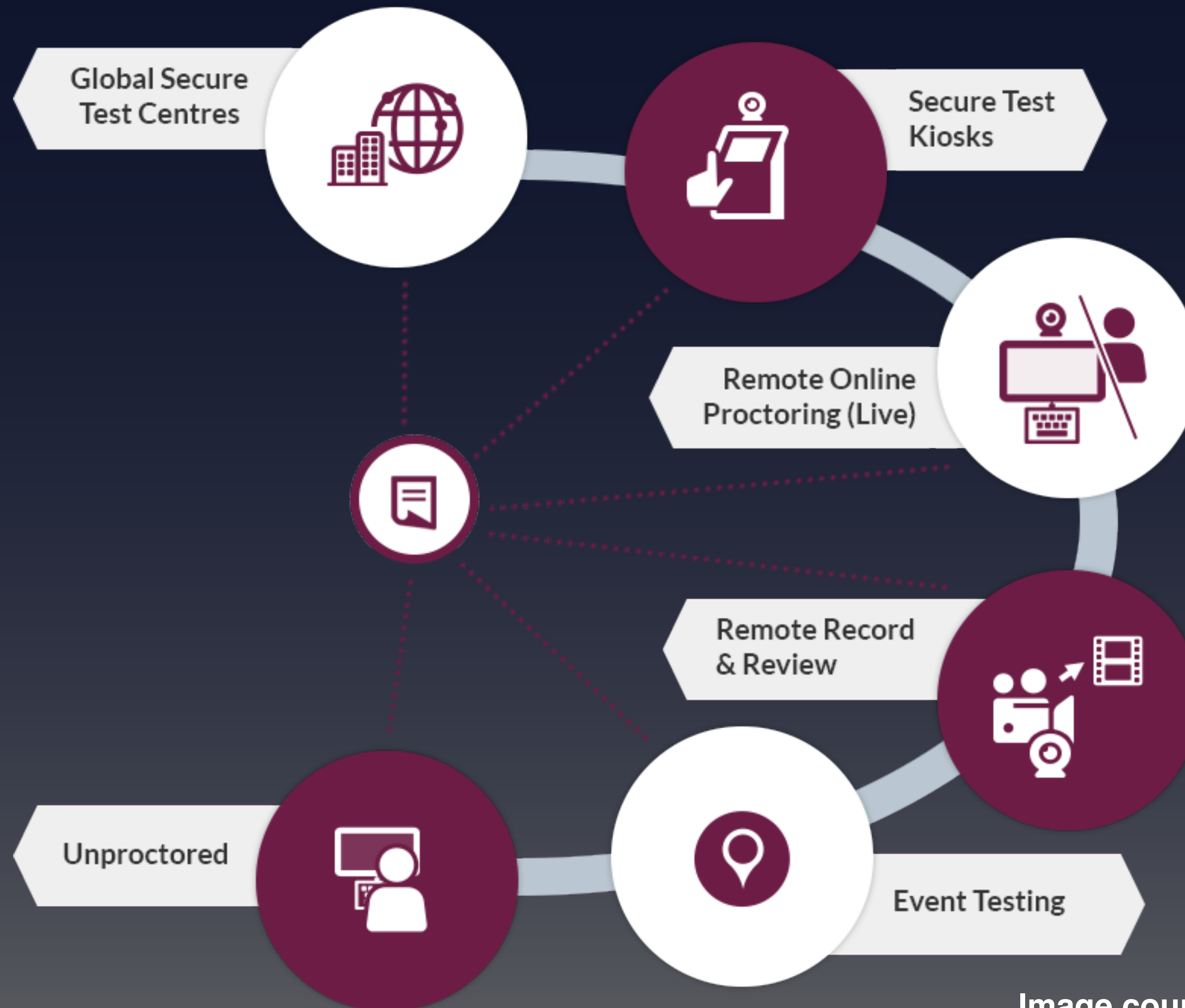
