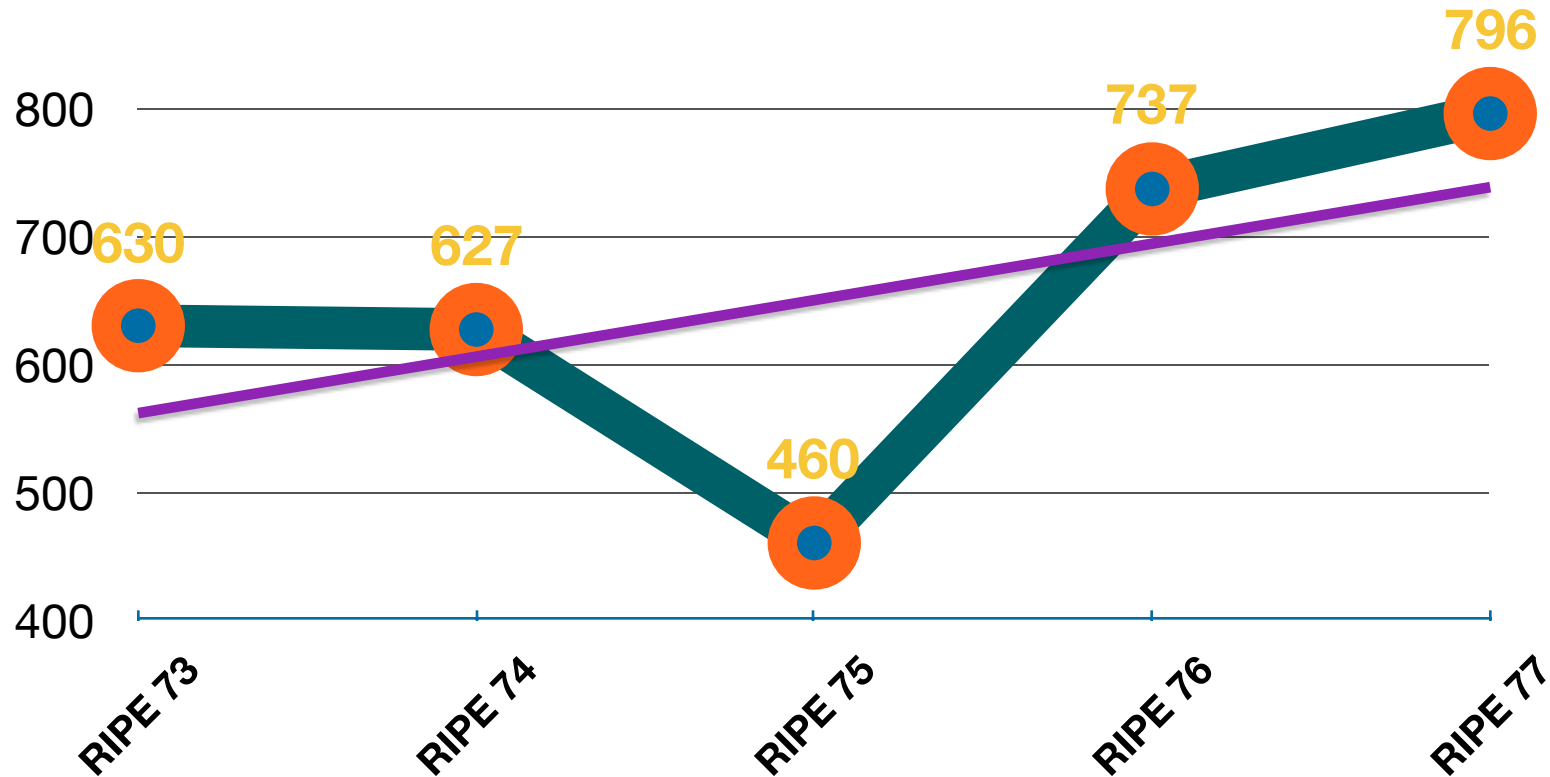

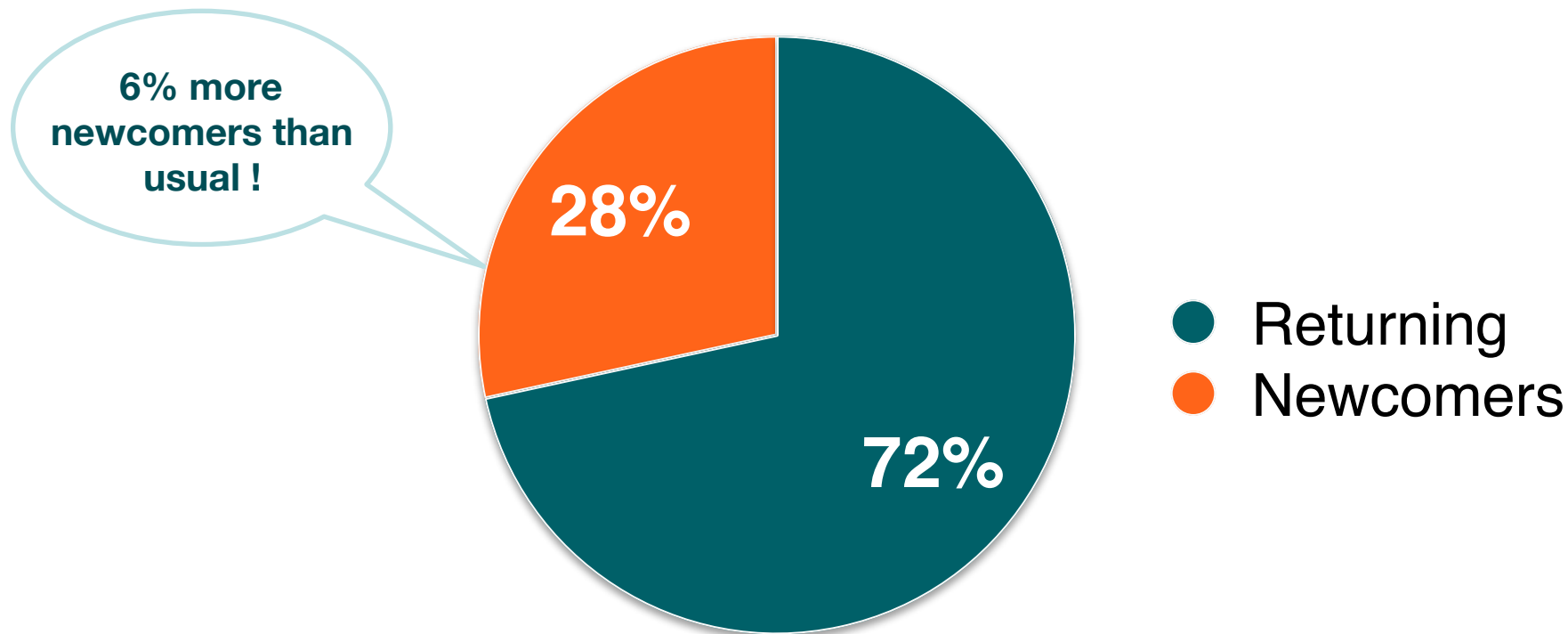

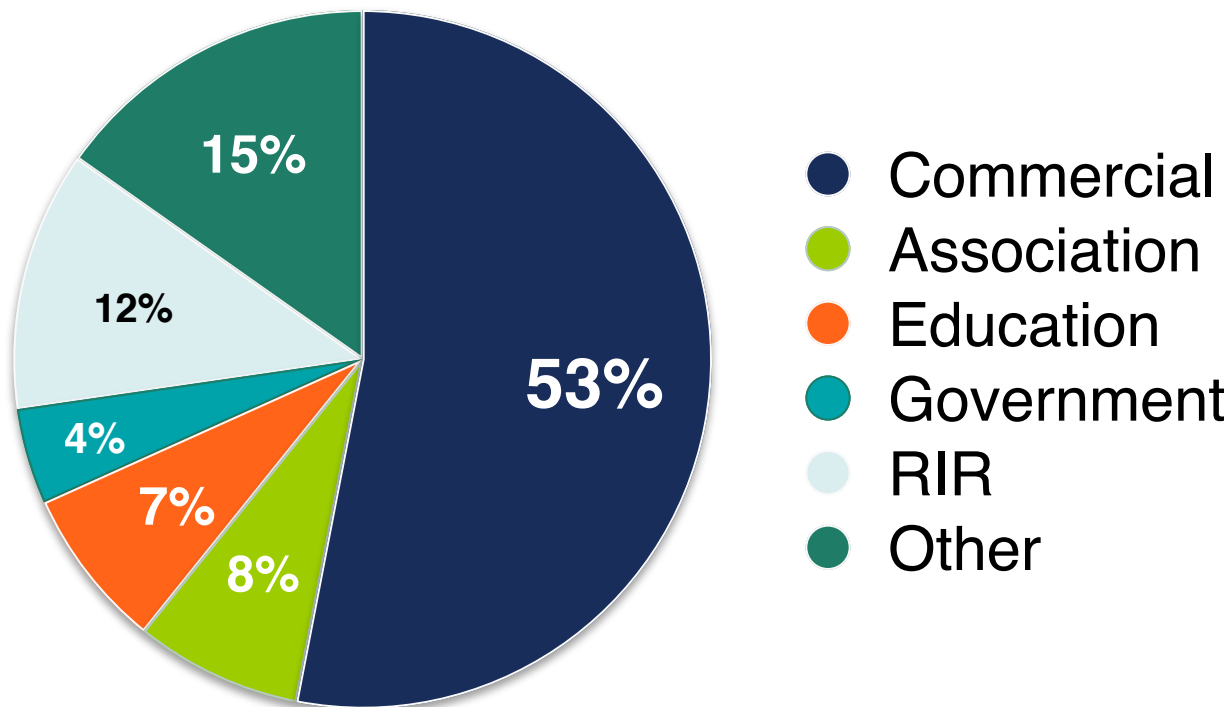
RIPE Meeting Attendance Over Time



Attendees at RIPE 77

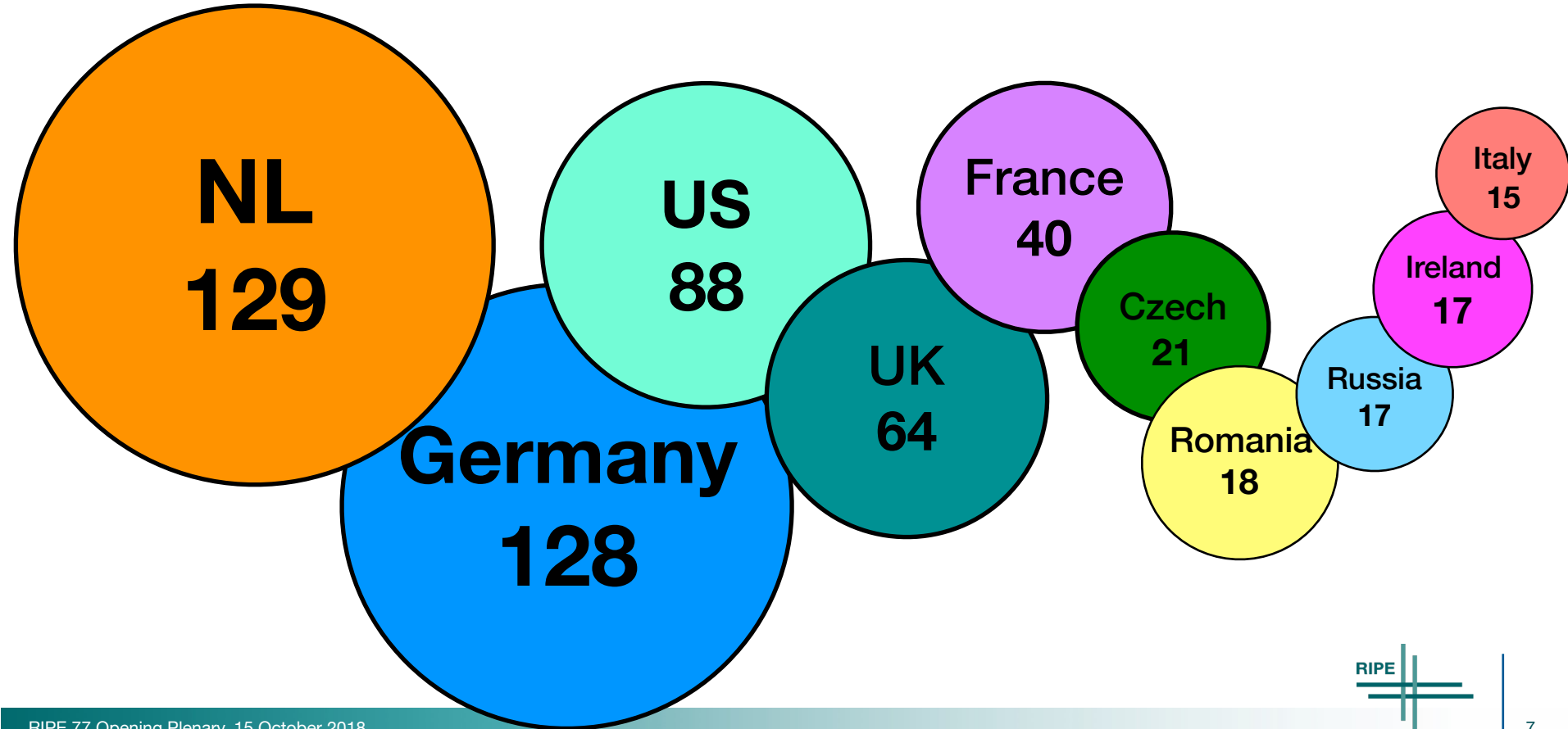


Attendees by Organisation
